


Amnos Newsletter

As we look back over the year 2018, we are grateful to the Lord for His blessings upon Amnos as we served Him with various programmes: Amnos Church Planting School, the Arise campaign, the monthly Intercede prayer meetings, the UK Christian Heritage Study Tour.



Arise 2018 was the fourth annual campaign to share the gospel. 129 delegates (youngest 13, oldest 83: photo) joined the evangelism training (25-28 June) and then moved out for outreach (29 June-5 July) to the 11 hosting churches in small groups of 9-14 people. National speak-



ers challenged them to live for Jesus, and trainers equipped them with practical skills. The teams worked hard for a week to support the hosting churches by reaching the people in their communities with the gospel.



We were encouraged this year to have more delegates from the UK than from the USA and Korea. A delegate wrote, 'Arise was an invaluable two weeks where I learned the purpose of my life.' On the night of 'Report & Celebration,' we heard so many testimonies of evangelism and of what God had done in their lives. God uses Arise for more than

evangelism training and outreach; He uses it too for lifechanging discipleship training. Pray for those delegates as well as those who heard the gospel through them.

We praise the Lord that most of the hosting churches, as well as the sending churches, have been partnering with Arise year after year. We take this as a sign that the campaigns have been helpful for those churches.





So, we are looking forward to what the Lord will do with Arise 2019. It will be held from 24 June—4 July 2019 at Trinity Church Brentwood. If you would like

Thank you for praying for us to recruit the right person to be our Dean. Though we could not find a Dean, through that procedure the Lord sent Alvin Davies to join the staff team on a part-time basis. He will focus on promoting the School and recruiting students. Alvin studied theology at

UK Christian Heritage Study Tour

Amnos has been hosting this Heritage Tour annually since 2013. It is to encourage Korean American church leaders to see the beautiful Christian heritage sites such as those of John Bunyan, John Wesley, William Carey, the Puritans and the Welsh revival. They also have opportunities to see the current spiritual climate of the UK, so they can pray more for the UK and for Amnos. A group from New Jersey, USA is coming 20-25 May, 2019.



A team from Virginia, USA, visited a small church in Colchester where Charles Spurgeon was converted by a simple message at the age of 16.

Many of these churches send their members to Arise campaigns as they saw the spiritual need in the UK. They have often said that the Lord challenged them to prepare themselves to share the gospel proactively as the churches in America are declining as well.

Daniel is Writing Books....

We thought it would be more strategic for Daniel Chae, our Executive Director, to spend some of his time doing



research and writing academic books. His *The Historical Paul in Acts* is due to be published on 1 January 2019 by Paternoster. London School of Theology has organised the launch of this book on 30 January at the College. Daniel believes that advocating and demonstrating conservative theology to academics is as important as shar-

ing the gospel with non-believers on their door-steps.

Please pray for him for wisdom, insight and concentration as he is writing another academic book on Paul, which will also be published later in 2019. His PhD thesis, *Paul as Apostle to the Gentiles* (Paternoster, 1997) has been well-received as it opened up a new horizon for the interpretation of Romans.
