Over 200 people gathered to give thanks to God for our six graduates and twelve new students at the Amnos Graduation and Induction Service, held on the 27<sup>th</sup> of September.

As reported in the last Newsletter, the first church plant by an Amnos graduate was done in Liverpool in May 2014. Two of the graduates this year are starting churches. She has been leading prayer meetings on Tuesdays, and from October, they are meeting in a school hall on Sundays. The official launch of the church is planned for a few months later.

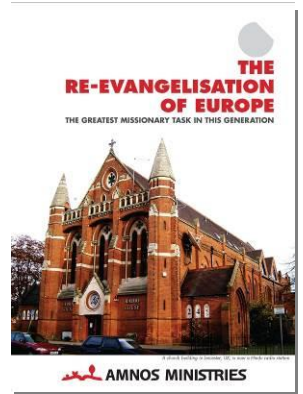

Being trained at Amnos she will step out in faith to hold a birth service of a church in Romford, Essex on the 1<sup>st</sup> of November 2014. We are grateful to God for strengthening them to take these steps of faith right after their graduation. Furthermore, one of the new students is planning to start a church in Dagenham, London before the end of this year. Because we have more evangelistic manpower this year, we are going to support these church plants by doing a systematic door-to-door outreach on Saturdays.

They are planting churches without the help of church or pledged financial support. Rather, they are stepping out in faith and obedience to plant churches. Though these new

plants are small in number, they are committed to the vision. Our graduates will make it grow through regular, continuous and prayerful outreach, as they learned at Amnos.
