Outreach with ARISE 2015



From 7-21 July, Amnos is organizing ARISE 2015, an exciting practical evangelism training and outreach campaign. This Campaign is in two parts:

(1) 7-11 July: evangelism training, (2) 11-19 July: practical outreach in small groups of 5-7 people at hosting churches. The aim of this new initiative is to support those churches with evangelistic manpower as well as to train participants in practical evangelism and discipleship. We are committed to sharing the gospel with as many people as possible.



Joining our ARISE programme are Dr Aija Kim, an internationally acclaimed pianist and Rev Rae-Chung Lim, a balloon and bubble artist. Dr Kim and Rev Lim will be holding special events reaching out to the communities around the hosting churches.
